



Nepali interpreters needed

The Asian Network for Free Elections (ANFREL) has established itself as the preeminent NGO in Asia working on elections, since 1997. ANFREL's main focus is in observing pre- and post-electoral processes, and developing and training civil society groups that are actively working on democratisation in their home countries. We also undertake specific research projects and advocate on good governance issues in Asia. ANFREL will conduct an election observation on the Nepal Constituent Assembly Elections from mid October to early December 2013.

ANFREL is therefore seeking highly qualified interpreters to join its Election Observation Mission, i.e. interpreter for the core team (1 person for 50 days), interpreters for the Long Term Observers (5 persons for 40 days) and interpreters for the Short Term Observers (20 persons for 10 days). As the interpreters will be supporting the work of election observers, they are required to travel and be accommodated in the observers' respective areas of responsibility. Candidates should be Nepali nationals able to communicate in English and have some understanding about Nepali politics and regions.
