



## Myanmar Situation Update 29 November - 5 December 2021

### Summary

The court in Naypyitaw has delayed the first verdicts in the trial of ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi until 6 December, the verdict expected to rule on 30 November. She faces two years in prison for the incitement charge for statements released by the National League of Democracy (NLD) when she was already being held in military custody. The second related to violating the Natural Disaster Management Law by attending a campaign rally during the 2020 General Election campaign<sup>1</sup>. Aung San Suu Kyi and the President Win Myint also hit with new corruption charges alleging not following existing laws and financial regulations when renting and buying the helicopter for use in the management of natural disasters and state's affairs.

According to the NLD central committee, 573 NLD members have been arrested by the junta and 12 have died in the junta's custody and detention following the coup in February<sup>2</sup>.

The former chairman of the Union Election Commission (UEC), Hla Thein and its two other commission members including Myint Naing and Than Htay, have been sent to Naypyitaw prison according to the lawyer. Chairman and the two commissioners were arrested on 1 February during the early hours of the coup. Media reported that Junta-appointed union election commission has been instructed to file lawsuits against the chairpersons and members of state/region, district and township level election sub-commissions who overlooked the 2020 general elections, according to one sub-commission member from Naypyitaw who has been in hiding since the February 1 coup<sup>3</sup>. Recently the junta-appointed Union Election Commission (UEC) filed charges against 16 people, including ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi, President Win Myint, former UEC Chair Hla Thein and UEC members Myint Naing and Than Htay over their alleged electoral fraud in the 2020 elections.

The junta leader senior general Min Aung Hlaing visited the house of 94 years, Tin Oo, the former Commander-in-Chief as well as patron of the NLD this week and gave his greetings.

Junta-run state media announced that more than 17 million people , 50 percent of the target group over the age of 18, are planning to vaccinate against COVID-19 by the end of December this year<sup>4</sup>.

According to the Ministry of Women, Youths and Children Affairs of the National Unity Government (NUG), junta's have killed around 100 children and at least 89 women across Myanmar from Feb. 1 to Nov. 17<sup>5</sup>.

The Karen National Union (KNU) declared that around 103 junta's troops were killed and other 88 were injured during 151 clashes in November in the Mutraw District (Hpapun) area of the KNU Brigade (5) territory<sup>6</sup>. According to Pyi Thu Yin Khwin or People's Embrace, a group helping the defectors, more than 2,000 soldiers and 6,000 police officers have now joined the Civil Disobedience Movement (CDM) against the junta and it expected that number would continue to grow in the coming months<sup>7</sup>.

Ko Aung Myo Htet, journalist and former editor of The Voice, was sentenced to two years in prison under Section (505-A) at the junta court.

In the United Nations' report, 46 percent of the population in the country could be living below the national poverty line by early 2022, at which time poverty in urban areas will have tripled since the crisis began<sup>8</sup>.

The UN Credentials Committee denied representation of the military junta at the UN and Ambassador U Kyaw Moe Tun continued in his post. Myanmar's civilian National Unity Government has welcomed a decision by a United Nations credentials committee<sup>9</sup>. The junta condemned the United Nations decision to deny its chosen representative.

Protests continued in different parts of Myanmar despite the crackdown by the junta over the week. The clashes between the junta forces and the civil resistance fighters or Ethnic Armed Organizations also emerged in all states and regions except Rakhine State.

According to the information compiled by ANFREL, at least 44 bomb blasts happened across Myanmar in the past week. It was reported that at least 10 people were injured and 15 died<sup>10</sup>.

As of 4 December, the Assistance Association for Political Prisoners (AAPP) recorded that 1,303 people have been killed by the junta. 7,750 people are currently under detention and 354 are sentenced. 75 have been sentenced to death and 1,963 are evading arrest warrants<sup>11</sup>.

### Timeline of events

29 November	
	U Hla Thein, the former chairman of the Union Election Commission (UEC) under the ousted civilian government, has been sent to Naypyitaw prison along with two other commission members, U Myint Naing and U Than Htay, according to the lawyer close to them <sup>12</sup> .
	<p>Nine female medics detained by junta's soldiers during a raid this month, are now being held at Kalay prison in Sagaing region, after a week of questioning with several allegedly suffering brutal treatment in junta's custody<sup>13</sup>.</p> <p>According to CDF Mindat, two people, father and son, stepped over the landmine planted by the junta army at (16) Mile divergent point on Mindat-Matupi Road. Reportedly, the father died of over bleeding on arrival at the clinic and his son had two fingers cut off<sup>14</sup>.</p> <p>Rohingyas in Buthidaung township, northern Rakhine State, hit with tougher travel restrictions by local authorities, requiring them to obtain a permission slip from an immigration office in order to leave the township<sup>15</sup>.</p>
	Daniel Kritenbrink, the US assistant secretary of state for East Asia, is on a visit to the region to reaffirm Washington's commitment to work with Southeast Asian countries and Myanmar is one of the agenda <sup>16</sup> .

Two junta troops were killed and some ammunition were confiscated in an attack on the Chaung Nak Gyi police station by the Burmese Student Organization (BSO) in Tamu township, Sagaing region<sup>17</sup>.

In Ayadaw township of Magway region, 7 alliance forces triggered a landmine on a junta's vehicle in Kan Phyu village and there were casualties. Similarly, a convoy of junta's forces consisting of one vehicle and 10 motorcycles were ambushed on Letpanto-Kanma road in Myaing township and there were many casualties and injuries<sup>18</sup>.

In Moenyin township of Kachin State, Moenyin PDF ambushed the convoy of junta's army carrying rations near Nanmar Letpantan village. Exchange of fire took place for hours and at least 8 junta's troops died in the attack<sup>19</sup>.

Roughly 5,000 inhabitants had to flee from at least nine villages in Sagaing Region's Depayin Township due to the air raids and shelling of junta's army, according to local sources<sup>20</sup>.

According to the junta's state-run television, a boat carrying 228 Rohingya were arrested by navy forces. Thirty-three children were among those detained in waters near Sittwe township in northwestern Myanmar, as well as five boat workers<sup>21</sup>.

Hakha's Christian leaders recommended for their congregations not to hold Christmas events this year due to the threat of political violence in Chin State amid the junta's army offensives, which aims to crush civilian resistance groups but also targets everyone else<sup>22</sup>.

### 30 November

According to the junta-controlled state's broadcaster, Myanmar's ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi and President U Win Myint have been filed with new corruption charges alleging not following existing laws and financial regulations when renting and buying the helicopter for use in the management of natural disasters and state's affairs<sup>23</sup>.

The first two verdicts that were due to be handed down to the Myanmar ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi after months of hearings, were postponed to 6 December, court sources said<sup>24</sup>.

According to local PDFs and residents, the junta helicopters had been scattering down propaganda documents in some townships of Sagaing Region with a growing influence of PDFs<sup>25</sup>.

The Ministry of Planning, Finance and Investment- NUG announced that due to a large volume of demand for their bonds, the sale process would be suspended from 30 November<sup>26</sup>.

Former national immunization director Dr. Htar Htar Lin and director-general of public health Dr. Soe Oo were filed under corruption charges, alleging they defied ministerial orders by returning international grants of 168 million kyats (US\$120,000), which was part of a COVID-19 vaccine grant to the United Nations<sup>27</sup>.

In Tantse Township of Sagaing region, the junta army which had stationed in Sitha Village, destroyed houses of local residents and slaughtered their domesticated animals<sup>28</sup>.

In Pinlebu Township of Sagaing region, Win Thein, chair of township USDP and candidate, and Nyo Than, allegedly junta informer, were both shot dead by some gunmen while they were sitting at a tea-shop<sup>29</sup>.

In the downtown area of Yangon, a traffic police booth was set on fire at Theinphyu-Bogyoke road traffic lights in Botahtaung Township<sup>30</sup>.

In Tamu Township of Sagaing region, local PDF conducted an ambush on junta soldiers who had come to the town for their salaries. Reportedly, the wife of the sergeant died and two junta's troops were injured<sup>31</sup>.

Chuang U People's Defence Force – CHU PDF said that two junta's soldiers were killed and three seriously injured in the targeted landmine attack at the traffic control outpost in Chuang U Town, Sagaing region<sup>32</sup>.

In Depeyin Township of Sagaing region, the junta armed forces were attacked with mines by Galon PDF in Myindan village. Reportedly, there might be many casualties among junta soldiers<sup>33</sup>.

In Minkin township of Sagaing region, local PDF intercepted the junta's army near Phatket village, 8 junta's troops died and 12 were severely injured<sup>34</sup>.

	In Kani township of Sagaing region, KLG PDF (Kani) ambushed and killed 3 junta's troops between Natgyi and Chaungwagyi villages <sup>35</sup> .
	World Food Program (WFP) said that it has started distributing food and rice to over vulnerable 800,000 people living in Shwepyitha, North Okkalapa and Dagon Seikkan townships of Yangon Region <sup>36</sup> .
<b>1 December</b>	
	According to the junta's newspaper, Kyaw Lin former Deputy Minister of Construction, Than Win; former Minister of Transportation in Bago Region, Deputy Director Aung Myint Oo, Ye Min Zaw and Nay Aung Ye Myint were charged under the anti-corruption law <sup>37</sup> .
	<p>Junta troops stormed the Mya Nanda housing complex in Chanmyathazi Township of Mandalay and arrested five government employees who joined the civil disobedience movement to defy against the junta<sup>38</sup>.</p> <p>Two men were killed by soldiers after being detained in Mandalay Region in separate incidents _ Than Tun Aung, a 25-year-old farmer, was detained, severely beaten to death by junta's army in Khine village of Myingyan township and another man, Phyo Maung Ye, the 30-year-old owner of the Today tea shop in Sintgaing Township's Kathe village, was shot in the leg three times and died in custody at the Hplanbo police station<sup>39</sup>.</p> <p>In Ayadaw township of Sagaing region, junta's army set the houses of Naung Gyi Ai village on fire following the incidents of their conoy having been attacked with landmines near the village<sup>40</sup>.</p>

	<p>The Kachin Independence Army (KIA) had 2 clashes with the junta's army in Hpakant and Mohnyin townships of Kachin State , said Colonel Naw Bu, the KIA's information officer and he didn't disclose details of casualties<sup>42</sup>.</p> <p>Junta released a statement that it had arrested 33 local resistance fighters and found guns, bombs and grenades in Mandalay region. that was a lie and among the detained people, the junta's army detained civilians who have absolutely no ties with the PDF or any revolutionary forces<sup>43</sup>.

In Bikka Village of Kyaikto Township in Mon State, a combined force of Karen National Liberation Army (KNLA) and local PDF conducted an attack on the junta army Ka-La-Ya Regiment (2) with a 40 MM grenade launcher. Reportedly, 4 junta soldiers died and 7 others were injured<sup>44</sup>.

In Shwebo Township of Sagaing region, a civilian vehicle carrying junta soldiers in plain clothes, was attacked with mines by a combined force of local PDFs near Ziphugone Village. At least 3 junta's troops died in the attack<sup>45</sup>.

Junta forces raided and burned down a training camp of the Theinni-People's Defense Force (PDF) in Hseni Township (also known as Theinni) in northern Shan State. Three junta's soldiers were killed in the raid, while 2 PDF members were detained and seven others injured, said Theinni PDF<sup>46</sup>.

Southern Pauk Guerrilla Force (SPGF) said that at least 26 junta's troops were killed in the ambushes on junta's troops patrolling in villages of Pauk township, Magway region from 29 November to 1 December<sup>47</sup>.

Three junta-appointed administrators and junta's informant were killed \_ administrator of Haymamarlar ward in Mahar Aung Myay township of Mandalay, Ingalargyi village administrator from Taikkyi township of Yangon and USDP campaign officer from Tootay township of Yangon<sup>48</sup>.

Tens of thousands of residents had fled away from the fighting that broke out recently in Kani Township, Yinmabin District, Sagaing Region. They have been temporarily relocated to nearby villages and are in urgent need of food<sup>49</sup>.

A total of 33 houses from Kukok village of Kalay township of Sagaing, have been set on fire by junta's army between 29 November and 1 December. Around 10,000 villagers from nine village tracks in the eastern corridor of myittamyit river have been displaced due to the continued military operations in the area<sup>50</sup>.

The junta slammed the United Nations decision to deny its chosen representative a seat at the United Nations and keep in place an envoy appointed by the ousted government of Aung San Suu Kyi<sup>51</sup>.

Junta has revoked the passports of dozens of several prominent Myanmar civilian politicians and anti-junta dissidents including the NUG Foreign Affairs Minister Zin Mar Aung and leading National League for Democracy lawmaker Aung Kyi Nyunt<sup>52</sup>.

On the 10th anniversary of signing the state/region level ceasefire agreement between government and Restoration Council of Shan State RCSS/SSA, it said that it will join hands with all parties to build a federal union holding the essence of Nationwide Ceasefire Agreement (NCA) through the new political meetings<sup>53</sup>.

In Paletwa of Chin State, the junta armed forces have been recruiting people from the IDP camp, including youth, by force for hard labour and military service<sup>54</sup>.

Incoming ASEAN chair, Hun Sen said that he is ready to visit Myanmar without any conditions in his capacity as the Cambodian prime minister<sup>55</sup>.

Mr Daniel Kritenbrink, the Assistant Secretary of State for East Asian and Pacific Affairs, said in a virtual roundtable meeting with media, that all options are on the table, thinking it is our responsibility not just as the US, but as the international community on the unacceptable coup defect and violence that has been carried out against the Burmese people<sup>56</sup>.

UN human rights experts called the junta to immediately halt ongoing forced evictions and home demolitions of informal settlements in Hlaing Thar Yar Township in the Yangon region, saying they must be provided with alternative accommodation and necessary assistance in accessing food, clothing, water and sanitation facilities and services<sup>57</sup>.

The Karenni Nationalities Defense Force (KNDF) has warned people of Kayah State not to travel by air to and from Loikaw, the Kayah State, as both passenger flights and military aircraft are now being used to bring in reinforcements and extra weapons to Kayah State<sup>58</sup>.

A former ward administrator named Myo Myint was shot dead in Aye Thukha ward, located in Mandalay's Maha Aungmyay Township and the Haymamarla ward administrator Hlaing Maung Win who was riding a motorcycle when he was shot dead in the head and neck as he approached the

No. 9 police station. Mandalay-based resistance group called Generation Z Power (GZP) claimed responsibility for the assassinations<sup>59</sup>.

The car carrying the junta officer and another was hit by landmines near the SUNDAY KTV restaurant in Myay Ni Gone Village, Thaton Township of Mon State. After the explosion, they arrested all the staff in KTV including the son of the KTV restaurant owner. Mon-Thaton Special Force(MTSF) claimed it was their act<sup>60</sup>.

The PDF Kalay ambushed and killed at least 15 soldiers sent as reinforcements from Kalay with landmines when they stopped near Chin Hsai while on foot to Nagar Pwet in Sagaing Region. In the afternoon, the junta's army burnt down houses and a chicken farm in Chin Hsai<sup>61</sup>.

In Thatone of Mon State, a military car on patrol was attacked with mines by local PDF at Pidagat Thonebone roundabout. Reportedly, 2 junta soldiers were injured<sup>62</sup>.

In Kyaikto Township of Mon State, there was fighting between the junta army and a combined force of Karen National Liberation Army - KNLA and local PDF in Shwegeyo Village. Reportedly, no less than 10 junta soldiers died and 5 others were injured. A CDM police officer lost his life from the side of PDF<sup>63</sup>.

A military convoy of over 30 junta soldiers was attacked with 6 mines by Kyaukse PDF at Mile Post No. (343 Mile 5 Furlong) on Yangon-Mandalay Expressway<sup>64</sup>.

In Myaing Township of Magway Region, local PDF conducted an ambush at the junta army in Bahin police station. Reportedly, there were many casualties among junta soldiers and police members<sup>65</sup>.

In Minkin Township of Sagaing region, local PDFs shot at 2 vessels of the junta area clearance operation team going down the Chindwin River near Nga Ohn Village. Exchange of fire took place, junta's army used heavy artillery and PDF could retreat without any harm<sup>66</sup>.

Local PDF ambushed the junta's convoy of 11 trucks carrying weapons and rations heading from Mandalay to Monywa. Two junta's troops died, many were injured and two civilians were injured in the attack<sup>67</sup>.

A group of people who were installing CCTV in ward (3) of Chan Mya Tharzi township of Mandalay, were shot by two people riding a motorcycle. Two people of the group were injured<sup>68</sup>.

	In Yangon, houses and shops within 300 feet of the road boundary along Mingaladon's No (3) highway road, are being forcibly demolished by bulldozers, including military vehicles, a custody vehicle and municipal vehicle <sup>69</sup> .
	According to Myanmar Press Freedom In- Depth (MPFI-D), Ko Aung Myo Htet, journalist and former editor of The Voice who had been arrested in Kanbalu Township, was sentenced to two years in prison under Section (505-A) at the junta court <sup>70</sup> .

	<p>Human Rights Watch claimed that junta's army deliberately encircled and used lethal force during the March 14, 2021, anti-junta protests in Yangon's Hlaing Tharyar township, killing at least 65 protesters and bystanders<sup>71</sup>.</p> <p>According to the Condo and Housing Committee, the junta had instructed to give the lists of residents at condos and housing in Yangon City by 3 December at the latest<sup>72</sup>.</p> <p>The junta leader Min Aung Hlaing said that the country had a great loss due to no full taxation for various reasons and no systematic customs on imports and exports at border areas<sup>73</sup>.</p> <p>The coup leader Min Aung Hlaing said that there were cases of bank staff breaking rules and doing wrong, and thus it was necessary for responsible personnel to monitor _ for ministries and state/regional governments to oversee to keep state-owned and private banks on the right track<sup>74</sup>.</p>
	<p>The junta's army arrested the head monk of Pope Pa Yone monastery in Nabu Ai Village, Myingyan township, Mandalay Region and had been taken to an interrogation centre at the Light Infantry Battalion (15) base under the 99th Brigade in Myingyan, according to the locals<sup>75</sup>.</p> <p>Junta's army sealed off the belongings of a regional MP from Tharsi township_ her house and shop were sealed off in Mandalay region<sup>76</sup>.</p>

Ranger Kalay Defend Force said that the junta armed forces, which had set fire to villages in Kalay Township, were attacked with mines on their return. Reportedly, 3 junta soldiers died and many were injured<sup>77</sup>. Later another 7 injured junta's troops died that night<sup>78</sup>.

A convoy of 22 junta's military trucks was attacked with landmines by an alliance of Black Eagle Defence Force – MMU and 4 other PDFs between Wampyae Village and Alla Kappa Village en route from Sagaing to Monywa township. Reportedly, two of the trucks were damaged<sup>79</sup>.

Two vessels carrying around 60 junta soldiers were attacked by a combined force of Kachin Independence Army (KIA) and local PDF in Parpaung village of Bamaw township, Kachin state. Exchange of fire took place, 3 junta's troops died and 8 were injured. Two villagers were injured and ward/village NLD member, U Myit Aye died due to the junta's heavy shelling<sup>80</sup>.

The junta army conducted invasive attacks at the Myanmar National Democratic Alliance Army - MNDA camp at Chinchaintan Mountain, three times in a day. A member of MNDA was injured and the injuries from the junta's army were unknown<sup>81</sup>.

In Myo Kone village of Sintgai township, Mandalay region, Sintgai PDF triggered 2 landmines on junta's troops who were at the liquor shop of the village. Twelve of the junta's troops were injured and there might be casualties<sup>82</sup>.

Around 10 clashes broke out in the control area of Karen National Liberation Army brigade (5) from 1 - 3 December and 6 junta's troops died and two were injured<sup>83</sup>.

In Kanbalu township of Sagaing region, junta's forces of policemen and Pyu Saw Htee members, who were asking money from passengers on Kanbalu-Kawlin road, were ambushed, killing 2 policemen and severely injuring one<sup>84</sup>.

In Yesagyo Township of Magway Region, U Marter, Pyu Saw Htee leader and retired soldier, was shot. According to the local PDF, he was shot again on the way to Monywa Hospital and died<sup>85</sup>.

Junta's troops stormed and shot the gem mine slot in eastern part of Mogoke township Mandalay. Two workers died in the shootout and the reason behind the killing was unknown. Later junta's troops sealed off the mine slot<sup>86</sup>.

Karen National Union regiment (1) announced the travel restriction that people are only allowed to travel within 6 AM - 6 PM in Hpa-An township. Similarly Chung-U PDF announced that Mandalay-

Chaug U- Monywa road and Mandalay - Chaug U -Pakokku road will be temporarily closed starting from 4 December<sup>87</sup>.

More than 100 residents at Kule village in the east of Minkin Township in Sagaing region, have fled their homes and sought shelters in the jungles<sup>88</sup>.

#### 4 December

Junta's army set the Thantlang Town on fire again and destroyed 19 houses, including a Christian Church known as United Pentecostal Church (UPC) and its headquarter building. Those residential properties impacted are mostly in Market ward located in the centre and in the middle of the town<sup>89</sup>.

In Ayadaw township of Magway region, junta's army stormed the Kanzwe village, destroyed some houses and school, killed and ate the livestock of villagers<sup>90</sup>.

The Civilian's Defense and Security Organization of Myaung (CDSOM) said in a statement that it has planned to control and examine ships entering and leaving Myaung town, Sagaing Region through five ports along the Chindwin River<sup>91</sup>. The junta has sent reinforcements to Sagaing Region's Myaung Township after the announcement of CDSOM to set up checkpoints at entry and exit points of the town<sup>92</sup>.

Junta-appointed ward (7) administrative officer from Nyaung Done township of Ayeyarwaddy region was shot dead by an unknown group of armed men on his way to the administrative office<sup>93</sup>.

The Chinland Defense Force (CDF Kanpatlet) ambushed the junta's troops stationed at the No (1) B.E.H.S in Kanpetlet township of Chin state for two times. On 3rd December, killing 2 junta's troops, injuring one and on 4th December, killing 2 junta's soldiers<sup>94</sup>.

In Sartaung town of Sagaing township, a convoy of 10 junta's trucks were attacked by landmines, destroying 4 vehicles and many were injured<sup>95</sup>.

Monywa UG Group said that they ambushed a junta's vehicle carrying the chief of Salingyi police station in Salingyi township of Sagaing region. The chief of the police station and another junta's officer were killed in the attack. The junta's troops killed a civilian<sup>96</sup>.

Exchange of fire took place as the unknown group of armed men attacked the police's checkgate at the Yale street of Maubin township, Ayeyarwaddy region. Details of the injury were unknown<sup>97</sup>.

In Htee Gyaint township of Sagaing region, local PDFs ambushed the junta's convoy consisting of 20 vehicles near Sardwin Mote Tahtaung, killing around 20 junta's troops, injuring many and 3 vehicles were destroyed<sup>98</sup>.

Secretary of USDP Htantapin's township as well as junta's informant was shot dead by a group of unknown gunmen in Yangon<sup>99</sup>.

Kachin Independence Army (KIA) intercepted the junta's convoy with 33 vehicles carrying weapons and rations with landmines between Mawlu and Pin Wai villages of Moenyin township of Kachin State. A civilian died due to the junta's heavy artillery shelling<sup>100</sup>.

Myaing Villages Revolution Front - MVRF ambushed the two civilian vehicles carrying junta's army with landmines on Myaing-Bahin road in Myaing township of Magway region, killing 3 junta's forces and one vehicle was destroyed<sup>101</sup>.

In South Dagon township of Yangon, a 100 household administrator from 133 ward of East Dagon together with his wife riding a motorcycle, were shot by an unknown group. The wife died on the spot and the administrator was severely injured<sup>102</sup>.

Thai patrol forces arrested 30 Myanmar nationals who illegally crossed the border in two groups into Sangkhla Buri and Sai Yok districts of western border province<sup>103</sup>.

Thousands of residents from 4 nearby villages of Minkin township had fled to the safer place as the junta's army stormed and stationed at the Zinkale village<sup>104</sup>.

Junta's minister of Education, Dr. Nyunt Pe said that the matriculation exam will be conducted from 30 March to 9 April<sup>105</sup>.

## 5 December

Coup leader senior general Min Aung Hlaing went to the house of U Tin Oo, the former Commander-in-Chief as well as patron of the National League for Democracy (NLD) and greeted, according to the

NLD lawmaker. Details of the reason for the visit is not yet known<sup>106</sup>. Min Aung Hlaing also met with General Khin Nyunt, the retired military intelligence chief and prime minister, at his house in Mayangone township of Yangon<sup>107</sup>.

In many places of Yangon, the sound of banging pots emerged following the incident of Kyimyindine's crackdown<sup>108</sup>.

According to the staff from the prison department who wants to be anonymous, a separate apartment was built in the Naypyidaw prison which will be used for Myanmar ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi after her verdicts<sup>109</sup>.

Junta's forces in a car rammed into an anti-coup protest in Kyimyindaing township of Yangon, with at least 5 protesters dead, arresting around 15 people, according to witnesses at the scene<sup>110</sup>. Another four civilians have been reportedly arrested in relation to the pictures and video of the crackdown on peaceful protesters trending on social media, allegedly accusing them of taking pictures and video from the apartment building<sup>111</sup>.

US embassy Yangon released a statement that they were horrified by reports that junta's forces were killing peace protesters in Kyimyindine of Yangon and called the Myanmar junta to end the use of violence, release those unjustly detained, and respect the will of the people<sup>112</sup>.

Generation Defense Force made an ambush on the junta's troops taking security at the Monywa's Myanmar Economic bank in Sagaing region. One junta's police died in the attack<sup>113</sup>.

A notorious junta's informant, Ko Min Min, who was involved in the brutal crackdown on Yangon's protesters today in Kyimyindine township, was shot dead after a few hours of the crackdown<sup>114</sup>.

Pa Cin Sian Sum, a well-known anti-junta resistance leader from Teetain township of Chin state was assassinated by two unknown gunmen at the place where he was hiding<sup>115</sup>.

Local PDF occupied the Nyaung Pin Thar police camp in Htee Gyaint township of Sagaing State and confiscated two Tumi guns (traditional hunting guns)<sup>116</sup>.
